Science Day on 28th February every year to commemorate the discovery of 'Raman Effect' by Nobel prize winning physicist Sir CV Raman. The theme of National Science Day this year is 'Indigenous Technologies for Viksit Bharat'. The same has been chosen for National Science Day to emphasise the relevance of indigenous innovations, to showcase the work of Indian Scientists. Institute of Life Sciences (ILS) is a prized institution working on the fore-front in research areas involving cancer biology, infectious diseases, plant biotechnology and interdisciplinary sciences. The institute has been consciously involved in contributing to novel technologies that are aimed towards the betterment of human health. In addition, it is one of the missions of ILS to communicate recent advances in science and technology to the general public and inculcates scientific temperament within the young students.

This specific programme was inaugurated and addressed by eminent scientist Dr. Debasis Das, Director, ILS in a video conferencing mode highlighting the contribution of ILS towards technological advancement for research and innovation in the field of bio-technology. He inspired our students to become future scientists and contribute towards welfare of the society.

Our students got the privilege of interacting with two of the eminent scientists Dr. Sandeep Mishra and Dr. Rajeeb Swain related to the ongoing research works being carried out by ILS and clarified their doubts.

During the seminar, Dr Mamoni Dash described the key highlights of the institute, enumerated about the product development of DBT-ILS, talked about the instrumentation facilities at DBT-ILS, flagship programme of ILS (Tribal Health and Nutrition), ILS in response to COVID 19, skill and capacity development, outreach calendar, upcoming outreach programmes and how the administration and the staff are committed to their duties to serve our progressive nation.

Dr Nivedita Jena delivered her seminar regarding role of bio-tech crops in increasing yield and resilience, application of digital tools in agriculture, bio-tech in health care, industries, energy, environment, recent trends in bio-tech, career opportunities in bio-technology and different funding opportunities.

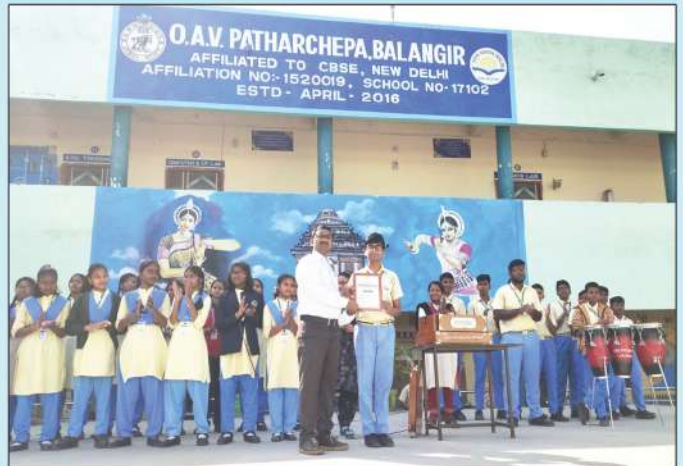

ART EXHIBITION & FOOD FESTIVAL



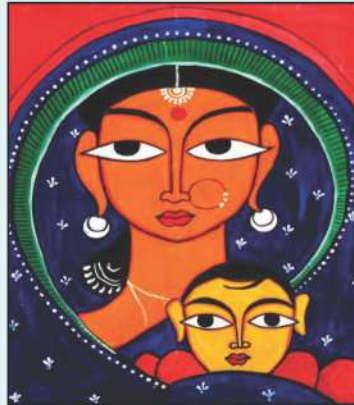

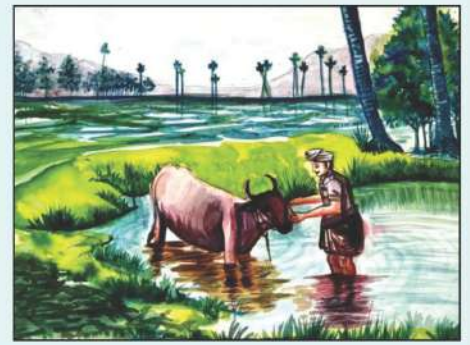

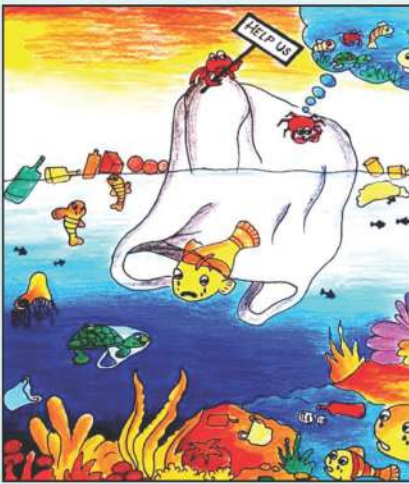
