DEFENCE, AVIATION AND SPACE SCIENCE

Defence, Aviation & Space Science [Karapalli, Ganiam]

In recent years, strategists and diplomats from space faring nations have engaged in debates with their foreign counter parts (and in some cases, with each other) on a range of issues related to norms and laws - or the relative lackthere by applicable to the military use of Space. Questions have run the gamut from the very broad (should the slim volume of outer space law be relevant to military platforms and operations be expanded?) to the very specific (what new technical tools are available for the verification of a regime of a notional future space arms control agreement?).

As a major space faring nation and leading military space power, United State's support for these as well as other initiatives proposing norms, rules, or laws relevant to the military use of space will play a significant role within the decision-making processes of other space actors weighing a unanimity to endorse or oppose these measures. At the same time, however, the support of the United States and its allies alone cannot necessarily guarantee the success of any proposed multilateral space initiative or agreement. Emerging space powers are increasingly making their voices heard on space issues, and represent important potential partners in future coalitions assembled to counter the 3

India is an increasingly important geopolitical player which is determined to attain recognition as a great Space power. Past and present Indian leaders, have unanimously agreed that advancements in science and technology are critical to the future development and security of their state. The country established a Department of Space in 1972 and has long linked its national space programme with the realization of broader national goals; its stated determination to achieve "Self-reliance in Space Technology," for example, is an ambition with important implications for the country's future economic and defence planning.

Eager to explore space, by capturing a share of the growing international space market, and project power across and beyond South Asia - and wary of the economic growth and military space developments of China - India is devoting significant resources to civilian and military space projects as well. The country currently has one of the world's largest space budgets (by one estimate, the sixth largest in 2010-11). The Department of Space's research arm, had exemplarily announced a 67 billion rupee (US \$1.3 billion) budget for the 2012-13 fiscal year.

Within the current community of space-faring nations, India is one of the few states outside of the major space powers to develop its own launch vehicle. Its Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV), at first launched in the year 1993, was the country's major space launch platform and has enjoyed a string of 18 successful launches since its last failure

India has also devoted significant resources to developing remote-sensing satellites designed to address pressing national needs, such as close monitoring of factors affecting crop yields and providing a range of data assisting disaster management response. ISRO proudly touts its current constellation of eleven satellites as the largest of its kind in the world

Space & Defence seeks submissions that will contribute to the intellectual foundation for the integration of space policy into overall security studies. The collaboration of soldiers, scholars, and scientists studying nuclear deterrence in the 1950s has led to a robust evolution of doctrine that shaped national and international policy for the succeeding forty years. Our goal as a center is to create this same ballistic dialogue with a research agenda that focuses on the integration of space policy and security studies.

Indeed, the emergence of space as a unique and critical element in national security, economic security, homeland security, cyber security, environmental security, and even human security has persuaded us that this line of inquiry is vital to the future of overall international security.

With respect to expansion of credible knowhow and to create a knack to accumulate more information and to keep up with upcoming trends, a district level Science Quiz Competition had been successfully organized on the 5th of November at AJO High School in the pristine environs of Phulbani. Students from various schools had converged after having cleared the block-level round to compete at the district level. There was a written round with a plethora of questions. Our IX th Grader Pragnyasmita Pradhan emerged victorious in the Senior category by bagging the first position, thereby representing our school at the State Level Quiz Competition held on the 8th of November, 2023 at Regional Science Center, Bhubaneswar. India has entered into the elite space club by becoming the fourth country to initiate a space probe (A space probe is an unpiloted, unmanned device sent to explore space and gather scientific information) on the and gather scientific information) on the moon after the US, China and Russia. All credits goes to ISRO(Indian Space Research Organization). ISRO has paved the way for economic space exploration and has set an example for developing countries to aim for space. Its journey started in 1962 under the guidance of an elite visionary Dr. Vikram Sarabhai. A milestone was achieved by creation and launch of INSAT (Indian National Satellite System) to satisfy tele communication. launch of INSAT (Indian National Satellite System) to satisfy tele communication, broadcasting, meteorology and other needs of the country. In 2013 we launched MOM (Mars Orbiter Mission), also known as Mangalyaan . We have launched our lunar missions including Chandrayaan I, II, III. We are the first country to reach the south pole of moon. Cost effectiveness is always on focus for any space mission. For that we depend on in-house technology, standardized any space mission. For that we depend on in-house technology, standardized components and adaptable systems. PSLV is designed to carry multiple bay loads in a single mission to optimize the resource use and less launching cost. Aditya L-1 mission has great significance in solar study. In future, we are aiming for ambitious Gaganyaan mission which targets to send humans to space. To unveil secrets of our neighboring planet unveil secrets of our neighboring planet Venus, we are going to send Shukrayaan. ISRO has inspired, is inspiring and will inspire millions of space enthusiasts.


